Italian for Holidays language course

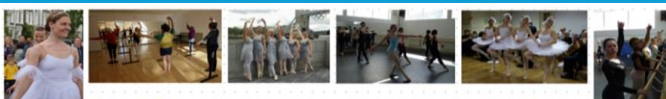
Wednesday from 18:00 to 19:30 (starting 10th July)

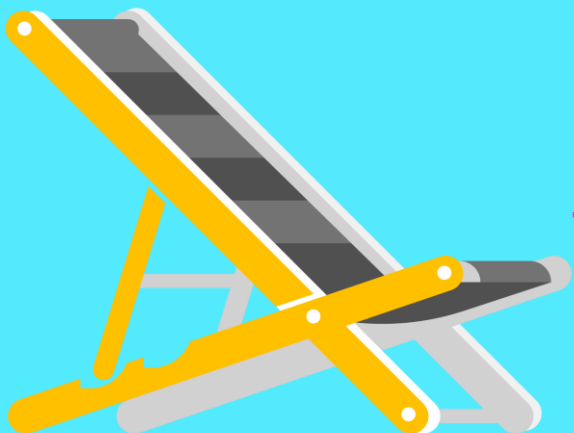
